

## Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriages - Rated by the blade carriage lifting capability, there are actually four sizes of hook type fork carriages. The hook type blade carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is about 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to hold loads as much as 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted forks can differ by the amount of offset between the blade eye and the tine. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
