These buckets are likewise 50% deeper compared to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra space makes them perfect for carrying irregular shaped loads such as moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.

The Quick-Tach is able to dump items approximately 1.5 feet higher because of the shorter depth of its bucket.
